COVID-19 Safer Standards Chart

Maximum Number of People	If the area of the gathering space exceeds 750 square feet, a number of persons up to ten (10) persons per 300 square feet of gathering space to a maximum of 50. <i>All numbers include clergy</i> <i>and lay worship leaders</i>	All numbers include clergy and lay worship leaders
Duration	One (1) hour or less total in the space	One and a half (1.5) hours total
Spacing	At least six (6) feet apart (including when at the altar) Every other pew/row of chairs cordoned off Do not seat persons directly in front of/behind one another	At least ten (12) feet on all sides (masks not required) between individuals or households At least six (6) feet on all sides (masks required) between individuals or households

Assigned or Recorded Seating/Placement This information is necessary for contact tracing so we may let people know if they may have been exposed to COVID-19. Masks (The CDC does not currently recommend use of face shields as a substitute for masks.
